

## Viscovery® 7.0.1 – What's New?

## Changes in Viscovery® SOMine 7.0.1

In **Viscovery® SOMine 7.0.1** the following errors were fixed that have been discovered in version 7:

- The settings at the top of the *Cluster Characteristics* window were not preserved when the window was closed and opened again.
- The group profile was not computed correctly when either the *Group Range* was set to *Neighborhood* or the reference group was defined from a *Neighborhood*.
- Typing the initial letters of an attribute name in a window listing attributes highlights the first occurrence of the letters typed. In some cases, this highlighting did not occur, however, when the attribute was outside the visible area of the list.
- The workflow titles were incorrect after a project created with Viscovery Predictor was imported.
- Attribute names in the legend of charts were truncated incorrectly for certain window sizes.
- In the *Define New Attributes* dialog, the values were cleared from the wrong column when an attribute formula became syntactically incorrect after a different formula was removed.
- The *Differences to the step above* were missing for the *Write Data Mart* step.
- An error indicating an invalid file format could have been reported under very rare situations.
- Double-clicking the line of a numeric computed attribute in the *Define Nominal Attributes* dialog could crash the application.
- Canceling the operation of the *Tune Histograms* step after closing the dialog showed an empty message box.
- The *Check Application* step of the *Classify* workflow would initially open with fewer than three attributes selected in some cases.
